## New words

Write these words out in different colours, write them with playdough, paint them, stick them on 3 places in your house and tap them with your hand when you pass and say the word. You will be able to sound out some of these words and you know some already from your tricky words.

Here is a sheet to read before we start our new book next week

I am in the park.

Luke is in the park.

Mammy is in the park too.

Luke has a kite.

It is red.

The kite goes up in the sky.

I run and run to get the kite.

Luke gets the kite.

Everyone is happy.

A great way to prepare your child for Senior infants is to practice writing sentences. You could pick each of the new words and put them in a sentence. Start by doing it orally. If your child is willing to, get them to write out the sentence. It can be a short sentence for now e.g kite: I see a kite in the park.
